### And

Novel Patent Services Pvt. Ltd. (NPS) having its office at Plot # 47, Opp. IIM-Vizag Road, Gambheeram, Anandapuram, Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh 531163, India is a top notch and the only fully established Intellectual Property Rights Organization offering a complete range of Intellectual Property Right education and outsourced services Including high-end research and analytics services, hereinafter referred to as "NPS" which expression shall where the context so admits include its successors and permitted assigns, of the second party.

AIET and NPS are hereinafter individually referred to as "Party" and collectively referred to as "Parties".

### 1. Preamble

- 1.1 Whereas, AIET, primary responsibility is to facilitate engineering education that embraces research and development of several projects during the course. Whereas, NPS primarily focusses on educating peers on Intellectual Property Rights, developing IP strategy and providing a collaborative platform in between academia, industry and investors.
- 1.2 The Parties hereby express their willingness to establish and support an Intellectual Property Cell (IPR Cell) within the premises of AIET.



### 2. Scope of MoU

The two Parties have decided to enter into the Memorandum of Understanding to jointly work on the following activities:

### 2.1 AIET

- 2.1.1 Shall establish and promote IPR Cell and its activities in the premises of the College of Engineering.
- 2.1.2 Shall provide an infra-structure ie., a physical space with projector, all the required facilities for conducting training and mentoring sessions regularly in IPR cell.
- 2.1.3 Shall engage solely with NPS in any of the IP related requirements.
- 2.1.4 Shall connect any project, thesis or research works of AIET to the IPR Cell, whereby all the workable projects can be adequately vetted by the Cell and be provided with the patentability opinions.
- 2.2 NPS
- 2.2.1 Shall be the IP partner for the AIET
- 2.2.2 Shall provide the adequate support like training, conducting workshops, preparing technical patent landscapes, providing patentability opinions to the ideas streaming in the IPR Cell on a regular need basis.
- 2.2.3 Shall be the teaching faculty for all the engineering students and the faculty at AIET and promote IPR education within the campus of AIET.
- 2.2.4 On a regular basis NPS conducts training, guiding & motivation on IPR by conducting physical classes atleast once a quarter.
- 2.2.5 NPS shall provide any needed advice or guidance or clarification on IP related matters over any communication means in ordinary scenario.

### 3. Duration of MoU

The total time-frame of the engagement would be for a period of 5 years from the date of signing this MoU. The term of this MoU may be extended as may be mutually decided by the Parties.

### 4. Financials

4.1 NPS shall be paid by AIET on a project-to-project or task basis (eg. Search, drafting & filing, IP Policy, etc.) on completion of the project or task.

4.2 In addition, travel allowance for any visits shall be paid to NPS as and when required during the execution of the duties according to the MOU by AIET.

### 5. Intellectual Property Rights

The legal rights over scientific and technical outputs based on the data and report generated in any study mutually undertaken would vest with both the parties. The Patent and other intellectual rights pertaining to any part of the project shall vest with first Party.

### 6. Confidentiality

The terms of confidentiality would be in accordance with the NDA that is separately signed and executed between both the parties.

### 7. AMENDMENTS TO MoU

No amendment of any provision of this MoU or any Addendum shall be effective unless it is in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both Parties hereto.

### 8. TERMINATION OF MoU

This MoU may be terminated by either of the Parties forthwith if the any other Party commits breach of any of the terms hereof and shall have falled to rectify such breach within sixty (60) days of the notice in this behalf having been served on it by the other Party.

## NON-BINDING TERMS

## Scope and Intent

EduSkills and Avanthi Institute of Engineering & Technology have decided to work together for the purpose of expanding digital skills into higher education system through offering various world class technical programs in Networking, Cybersecurity, Cloud computing, automation, RPA and other industry 4.0 skills to their students.

## 2. Proposed obligations of EduSkills:

- To offer digital content and courses of up to 8 global academy programs to the institution.
- To offer LMS of the academy programs, where ever applicable.
- To offer branding collaterals access and usage of academy programs.
- Train the Trainers' to the nominated educators by the institution.
- Virtual orientation session/workshop for the institution.
- In-person/remote support for any troubleshooting needed during the onboarding process.
- To offer opportunities to participate in job fairs, seminars, conferences and any regional/national/global competitions or platforms for the students, educators and/or institution's leadership.
- EduSkills Talent Connect Program for students
- EduSkills & AICTE Internship Program for students.

## 3. Proposed Obligations of Avanthi Institute of Engineering & Technology:

- To create awareness for adoption and registration of technical courses from interested students.
- To nominate a point of contact who could monitor and review the program updates.
- Pay membership fee every year. Following year's membership fee can be incremented on nominal basis, if the need arises. Agreement to be renewed after 3 years.
- Minimum 100 students' commitment for each academy program every year.
- To ensure following pre-requisites to be followed by the participating colleges:
  - High speed broadband connectivity, computer labs for relevant courses and classroom IT set-up for all participating institutions.
  - b. Identify up to 2 (Two) Educators with required qualification like Engineers/MCA in Computer Science/IT/Electronics, etc. or experienced diploma holders to receive Training of Trainers for each academy program.

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is effective from the date of signatures below ("Effective Date"); hereinafter, each a "Party" or together, "the Parties". EduSkills will be referred as 'First party' and Avanthi Institute of Engineering & Technology will be referred as 'Second party'.

The Parties have been discussing a proposed collaboration in the area of "Skill Development, IT Education and Workforce Development Programs" ("Collaboration Areas").

Now the Parties agree as follows:

## A. NON-BINDING TERMS.

The Parties understand that MOU is intended only to summarize the current understanding of the parties with respect to the principal terms of the proposed collaboration.

The Parties understand that this MOU is intended only to summarize the current understanding of the Parties with respect to the Collaboration Areas and to facilitate their further discussions regarding certain objectives of the proposed partnership, as more fully described in Exhibit A, which are non-binding on the Parties. The terms and objectives set forth in Exhibit A shall be used for discussion purposes only and shall not be deemed to create any rights or obligations for or on behalf of any Party.

## B. BINDING TERMS

The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree that the following subsections under this Section B (Binding Terms) shall be binding and create legal rights and obligations on the Parties.

## 1. Confidentiality

In this MOU "Confidential Information" means any information or data, irrespective of the form and nature thereof, that is material to the Party disclosing such information ("Discloser") to the other Party ("Recipient"), including, but not limited to technical know-how, specifications, designs, models, software, techniques, drawings, processes, as well as industrial and intellectual property rights, business information, trade secrets, customer lists, financial information, process, costs, sales and marketing plans, information posted on their respective websites or any other information with the Recipient knows or reasonably ought to know is confidential, proprietary or trade secret information of the Discloser.

The Recipient shall at all times, both during the term of this MOU and for a period of at least three (3) years after its expiration or termination, keep in trust and confidence all such Confidential Information, and shall not use such Confidential Information other than for the purpose of fulfilling its obligations under this MOU, nor shall the Recipient disclose any such Confidential Information to any third party without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent. Upon termination of this MOU or written request from the Discloser, the Recipient shall, within fifteen (15) days from such termination or request, return all Confidential Information and any and all copies thereof to the Discloser, or at the Discloser's option, destroy the Confidential Information and any and all copies thereof, and certify such destruction

The obligations of confidentiality set forth herein shall not apply to information which;

- Was rightfully in possession of or known to the Recipient without any obligation of confidentiality prior to receiving it from the Discloser;
- b. Is, or subsequently becomes, legally and publicly available without breach of this MOU:
- Is rightfully obtained by the Recipient from a source other than the Discloser, without any obligation of confidentiality; or
- d. Is developed by or for the Recipient without use of the Confidential Information.

The Recipient may only disclose Confidential Information pursuant to a valid order issued by a court or governmental agency, provided that the Recipient provides the Discloser

a. Prior written notice of such obligation; and

The opportunity to oppose such disclosure or obtain a protective order.

The Confidential Information shall remain the property of the Discloser and no license to any existing or future intellectual property rights or Confidential Information is granted or implied under this MOU All Confidential Information is provided "AS IS". The Discloser shall not be hable for any inaccuracy or completeness of the Confidential Information, nor are there any express of implied to presentations or

warranties by either party to the other, including with respect to the infringement of any intellectual property rights or any right of privacy, or any rights of third persons.

### Scope

The scope of this MOU does not cover any development work, testing, licensing, distribution, support, sales, or maintenance. Should the Parties decide to pursue such matter that is outside the scope of this MOU, the accordingly.

## Publicity

The Parties hereby agree that no press release or other public announcements regarding this MOU or any agreements contemplated thereby shall be made without prior review and written agreement signed by a duly authorized representative of the other Party.

## 4. Term and Termination

The Parties agree that this MOU shall be effective as of the Effective Date and shall continue in effect until the earliest occurrence of one of the following: (1) the execution of a definitive MOU or definitive agreement relating to the scope of this MOU; (2) written notice by one Party to the other of termination of this MOU; or thirty-six termination of this MOU. Upon expiry of the Term, it is the intention of the Parties to further progress the solutions initiated under this MOU towards overall achievement of the objectives and outcomes contemplated projects to further the objectives set forth in the MOU.

## 5. Limitation of Liability

Except for liability relating to either Party's breach of the other Party's confidential information or intellectual property rights, in no event shall either Party be liable to the other Party for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, punitive or consequential damages or loss of profits, lost revenue or loss of data.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in this MOU shall limit the Parties liability for bodily injury or death caused by its negligence or its liability in the tort of deceit.

## Intellectual property rights

Each Party will retain the exclusive rights, title and ownership of all its pre-existing Intellectual Property, Confidential Information and materials (including, without limitation, proprietary ideas, sketches, diagrams, text, know-how, concepts, proofs of concepts, artwork, software, algorithms, methods, processes, identifier codes or other technology) owned or developed by such Party.

## Governing laws and jurisdiction

The Parties shall make efforts in good faith to amicably resolve all disputes as may arise out of or in connection with this MOU. This MOU shall be subject to and governed by the laws of India and the Indian courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any claim arising under this MOU. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either Party may seek interim injunctive relief in any court of appropriate jurisdiction with respect to any alleged breach of such Party's intellectual property or proprietary rights.

### Costs

Unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, each Party shall bear its own costs and expenses arising in connection with this MOU and the possible negotiations, completion and implementation of definitive Agreements if any, including but not limited to costs of experts, consultants, lawyers and travel expenses.







APSSDC and College shall herein after be collectively referred to as Parties and individually as first/second Party.

#### WHEREAS:

This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of Initia and subject to the arbitration clause mentioned above, the courts of Anillira Pradesh shall have the jurisdiction to entertain any dispute or suit arising out of or in relation to this Agreement.

#### PUBLICITY

Neither party shall make any public disclosure, except as may be required by applicable law, relating to discussions and or terms related to this Agreement, without obtaining the prior written consent of the other party. Either party shall not use and shall not let their employees, agents and subcontractors from using the name, trademark or logo of other party in any sale, marketing publication, advertisement, or other publication. Either party shall not make, or let its employees, agents or subcontractors make, any public statement relating to the other party.

#### 17. RELATION OF THE PARTIES

Nothing herein shall be construed to neither constitute a partnership between the parties hereto nor to authorize the College save and except as provided herein or with the APSSDC's prior consent in writing, for making any representation.

#### 18. MODIFICATION, AMENDMENT, SUPPLEMENT OR WAIVER

No medification, amendment, supplement to or waiver of this Agreement or any of its provisions shall be binding upon the parties hereto unless made in writing and duly signed by the authorized representative of the party against whom enforcement thereof is sought. Any failure or delay of any party to this Agreement to enforce at any time any of the provisions of this Agreement or to exercise any option which is herein provided, or to require at any time performance of any of the provisions hereof, shall in no way be construed to be a waiver of such provisions of this Agreement.

#### 19. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement together with all Appendices, Attachments and Addenda attached hereto constitute the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all previous agreements, promises, representations, understandings and negotiations. whether written or oral, between the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof.

#### 20:ASSIGNMENT

The Second Party shall not be entitled to, nor shall it purport to, assign this Agreement, without prior consent of the First Party.
